COPPER BEECH TREE

The South Avenue Park Copper Beech Tree, one of four historic beech trees in the Village of Brockport, stood proudly at 52 South Avenue for more than 125 years. Scientifically classified as *Fagus sylvatica*, a monoecious species, this remarkable tree was a cherished landmark. During an October 2021 windstorm, the tree split at a fork near its base and had to be taken down. The largest piece of the trunk was saved and turned over to Kurt Caruso and Chad Fabry, two gifted local woodworkers. Together, they crafted this beautiful conference table.
