## Resolution Regarding SUNY Impact Aid

**WHEREAS** according to the US Census 52.4% of housing stock in the Village of Brockport is tenant occupied, and approximately 60% of that is SUNY Brockport student occupied;

**WHEREAS** student off campus rental housing accounts for an estimated \$100,000 of the Village's Code Enforcement Department's budget;

**WHEREAS** the Brockport Police Department regularly responds to calls for off campus party noise, conflict, and overcrowding, attends to the orderly 2am closing of village bars whose patrons are predominantly college students, provides police coverage for SUNY events held off campus in the Village, and assists University Police when needed;

**WHEREAS** approximately \$150,000 of the Brockport police budget, the cost of one full-time officer with benefits, is directly related to SUNY Brockport;

**WHEREAS** 65% of the value of property in the Village of Brockport is tax exempt due primarily to SUNY Brockport the majority of which lies within the Village's boundaries, leaving village taxpayers with the highest property taxes in Monroe County;

And, **WHEREAS** the Village of Brockport received SUNY Impact Aid in the amount of \$210,000 in 2018 but has received none in successive years;

Be it **THEREFORE RESOLVED**, on January 10, 2024, the Village Board requests that SUNY Impact Aid for the Village of Brockport be restored in 2024 in the amount of \$250,000 and continue.

Trustee Kristansen moved, Deputy Mayor/Trustee Crane seconded, to adopt the resolution.
