The Monika W. Andrews Creative Volunteer Leadership Award is presented to an eligible person or persons who have demonstrated outstanding leadership in volunteer work by undertaking important innovative activities or creating significant new ways to serve the greater Brockport community which includes the Towns of Sweden and Clarkson. The committee wishes to remind nominators that they can resubmit nominations in the future, for their nominee, if not selected.

Though the award is for individuals the committee acknowledges the following organizations that were nominated. A letter submitted by Allyn Hammel, highlights the Brockport Lions Club for a multitude of initiatives that have improved the quality of lives in our community over the past 70 years. A letter by Jackie Smith, recognizing the dedication and service of the Brockport Community Connections Board connecting residents and SUNY Brockport students to all types of resources in the community. The committee recognizes and is truly appreciative of the service that the many volunteers within these organizations provide our community.

This year there also two nominees deserving honorable mention. Jeff Harradine and Dave Howlett were nominated by Robert J. Lewis for their commitment to the community through their work with the Brockport High School Alumni Association. Both Jeff and Dave have served as President of the Alumni Association and have helped the school district with initiatives such as gathering historical information about the district and working toward a permanent place to display the curated collection at the Oliver Middle School. Additionally, Jeff and Dave have shown significant commitment to our community by serving as school board members. The volunteer leadership of Jeff Harradine and Dave Howlett are recognized and appreciated.

This year's recipient of Monika W. Andrews Creative Volunteer Leadership Award goes to Peggy and Gordy Fox.

Authors of nomination letters in strong support of Peggy and Gordy Fox include: Gary Skoog, past president of the Morgan Manning House, Rozenn Bailleul-LeSuer, consulting curator for the Morgan-Manning House Museum, Archie and Patty Kutz, Mike and Linda Schaeffer, Andrea and Skip Perry, and Sharon Wheat.

The letters highlight Peggy and Gordy's dedication, creativity, and leadership in their exemplary volunteer efforts. Specifically mentioned is their work to preserving the historic Morgan-Manning House. Gordy is recognized for his leadership and woodworking skills. Peggy is

acknowledged for organizing the house's furnishings and archives and volunteering for educational programs. Both can be counted on to help maintain the house as well as help with the set-up and take-down for Morgan Manning events.

Of particular note, SUNY Brockport named Gordy the “Alumnus of the Year for Community Volunteerism” in 2017. Gordy constructed and donated multiple “Little Free Libraries” mounted in the Village of Brockport. Both Gordy and Peggy generously volunteer service to the Seymour Library and a willingness to help others within the community.

Please have brush ready and at the curb the *night before pickup begins*.
Each street will get one pass during the week of pickup.

- **Pickup Starts Monday, April 21st**
- **Pickup Starts Monday, May 19th**
- **Pickup Starts Monday, June 23rd**
- **Pickup Starts Monday, July 21st**
- **Pickup Starts Monday, August 25th**
- **Pickup Starts Monday, September 22nd**
- **Pickup Starts Monday, October 27th**

Please note:

- ***Keep limbs under 10ft in length.***
- ***Do not place between poles or signs.***
- ***Do not place brush in the road.***

For items other than brush you should contact your refuse hauler.

NOTICE TO BROCKPORT RESIDENTS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT WATER MAIN FLUSHING in the Village of Brockport will take place April 15th-17th 2025.

As part of our routine maintenance of the water distribution system in the Village, Department of Public Works crews will be flushing water mains on **April 15-17, 2025**. We do this periodically to clean the mains and flush out sediment accumulations that may settle out in the mains. The flushing will ensure that you have a safe and healthy supply of drinking water.

Flushing operations will be conducted between 9:00 A.M. and 1:00 P.M. in the following locations on the date indicated:

Tuesday, April 15, 2025:
All hydrants NORTH of the canal.

Wednesday, April 16, 2025:
SOUTH of the canal
All hydrants EAST of Main Street

Thursday, April 17, 2025:
SOUTH of canal
All hydrants WEST of Main Street.

During flushing you may see some cloudiness or color in the water. Please do not use any unnecessary water during this period. The flushing may cause the water to become "cloudy" or "discolored". While the water will be safe to drink, we suggest that you do not wash clothes if you notice the water is discolored. **ANYONE ON A KIDNEY DIALYSIS MACHINE, PLEASE CALL THE SUPERINTENDENTS OFFICE AT THE NUMBER BELOW!**

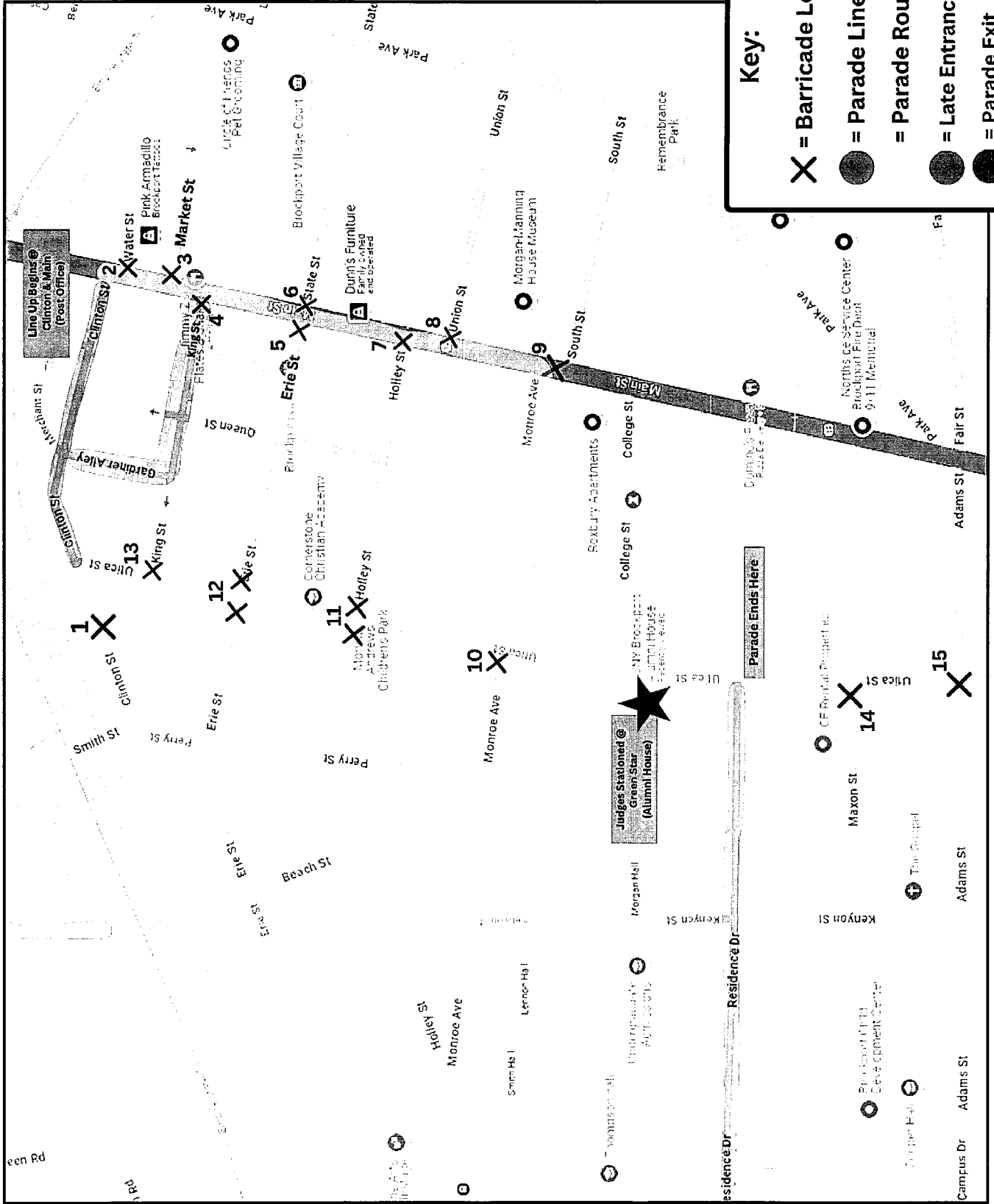
