Committee Structure: Nine members and two Village Board liaisons meet every second Wednesday (Apr-Oct) 7:00 p.m.

Members Responsibilities: Each member is responsible for overseeing a specific park and reporting problems/ideas.

Department of Public Works: In charge of maintenance and safety of the parks. The Parks Committee works with Dan Verace, DPW Superintendent, and has advisory authority to the Village Board.

Recent Park Improvements:

- ZipKrooz in Barry Street Park (2019) – Community Build with DPW, funded with Park's budget reserves
- Bicycle Repair Station/Two Electric Vehicle Charging Stations (2019) in Harvester Park at the Welcome Center
- New trees planted in Corbett Park (2021) – through a NYSDEC UCF Program grant
- Updated trails, MVP Fitness Court, basketball, tennis, and pickleball courts in Corbett Park (2022)
- Resurfacing of promenade at Harvester Park (2024)
- Installation of sensory equipment and path at Sagawa Park (2024)
- We Go Round installed at Monika Andrews Children's Park (2025)

Budget: There is \$8,500 on the Parks Budget line (June 1-May 31). Additional revenue from Brockport Arts Festival Proceeds. Some expenses are in the DPW budget.
